**GENERAL SAFETY REGULATIONS**

To the Student:

Students involved in the Robotics program will be working in shop areas where their personal safety and the safety of others will depend upon the strict obedience to the following regulations. Your cooperation is expected.

1. No “horseplay” of any kind is permitted.
2. Throwing objects in the class/shop is hazardous and will not be allowed.
3. Sandals do not protect the feet adequately for shop work and are not permitted.
4. Safety goggles are required by law to be worn in the lab area **at all times**, and when working with equipment that necessitates the need for safety goggles.
5. Every student when working with equipment must roll sleeves above the elbows.
6. Hoodies and jackets must be removed before operating equipment.
7. Loose clothing must be removed or confined in an apron.
8. Long hair is hazardous; keep it trimmed, tied back, or wear a cap, which will be supplied.
9. Do not handle or operate shop equipment unless you have first received permission and instructions.
10. Students will clean up the shop area that is assigned by the advisor.
11. The advisor will issue safety instructions pertinent to the shop’s equipment.
